Air Force Reserve Recruiting Service Applicant's Rights + Responsibilities



- During your recruiting process, you will be treated with respect and professionalism. "Integrity, Service Before Self, and Excellence in All We Do" are the core values we live by.
- Recruiters will not and shall not establish, develop (or attempt to develop) or conduct an unprofessional relationship with a recruit or applicant. This includes, but is not limited to, favoritism, misuse of position, dating, handholding, flirting, kissing, embracing, caressing and engaging in sexual activities.
- You have the right and obligation to report unprofessional relationships or improper or immoral behavior by Air Force Reserve Recruiters or other DoD members to the proper authorities without fear of reprisal.
